Question:

For the periods 1 July 2010 to 30 June 2011 and 1 July 2011 to 31 December 2011:

- 1. How much has been spent on optical surveillance?
- 2. How many clients were subject to this surveillance?
- 3. How many of those under surveillance resulted in no action being taken?
- 4. What was the cost of the surveillance where no action resulted?

Answer:

- 1. 1 July 2010 to 30 June 2011- \$755,294 1 July 2011 to 31 December 2011- \$226,257
- 2. 1 July 2010 to 30 June 2011 4121 July 2011 to 31 December 2011 225
- 3. For the period 1 July 2010 to 30 June 2011, 188 investigations using surveillance warranted no further action.
 - For the period 1 July 2011 to 31 December 2011, 70 investigations using surveillance warranted no further action.
- 4. The actual cost of using surveillance in cases that warranted no further action is not readily available, and not cost effective to obtain.
