- b) If so, what steps are being taken based on recommendations of the group?

Answer:

- a) Two.
- b) As foreshadowed in the 30 September 2011 Pharmaceutical Benefit Scheme (PBS) Deferrals Statement of Principles of Commitment between Stakeholders, the joint chairs report was provided to Government on 12 December 2011. The report is currently being considered by the Government.
