Written Question on Notice

Senator McKenzie asked:

- a) Does the Department/Agency provide their Ministers and/or Parliamentary Secretaries and/or their offices with any electronic equipment?
- b) If yes, provide details of what is provided, the cost and to who it is provided.
- c) What equipment is provided to Department/Agency staff?
- d) Please list what the equipment is, the cost, the classification of the staff receiving the equipment and the reason why.

Answer:

- a) Yes.
- b) Each of our Ministers and Parliamentary Secretary have the option to use a range of electronic equipment including a blackberry, mobile broadband card, printer, laptop, and desktop computer. General office equipment such as multi-function devices, printers including secure Cabnet printers, televisions, DVD players, transcription kits, label makers and fax machines are allocated to each office for use by the Ministerial Office.
- c) Departmental staff working in the Ministerial Offices at Australian Parliament House are issued a Blackberry, mobile broadband card, desktop computer and laptop if required.
- d) All equipment is provided in order for the Ministers / Parliamentary Secretary, their staff, Departmental Liaison Officers and and Graduates working in Ministers' and Parliamentary Secretary's offices to undertake portfolio related business. Previously purchased items returned to the Department of Health and Ageing are redeployed wherever possible within Ministerial / Parliamentary Secretary offices.
