Written Question on Notice

Senator Boyce asked:

How much is every other state and territory receiving under the 2010 National Partnership Agreement for subacute care?

Answer:

Under the National Partnership Agreement on Improving Public Hospital Services (NPA IPHS) states and territories will receive up to the following amounts for the New Subacute Beds Guarantee Funding element (2010-11 to 2013-14): New South Wales \$527.4 million; Victoria \$402.4 million; Queensland \$327 million; Western Australia \$166.4 million; South Australia \$119.7 million; Tasmania \$37.3 million; Australian Capital Territory \$26.1 million; and Northern Territory \$16.9 million.

Total funding provided by the Commonwealth under the New Subacute Beds Guarantee Funding element is \$1.623 billion (2010-11 to 2013-14).
