Over the past five years the Department has engaged in appropriate consultations, including face to face meetings, and sought advice from a range of Australia's key national research bodies, industry representatives and other relevant experts, when developing alcohol policy, including:

- Distilled Spirits Industry Council of Australia (DSICA)
- Brewers Association of Australia and New Zealand
- Winemakers Federation of Australia
- The Australian Wine Research Institute
- Drinkwise Australia (Governed by a board of seven community and six alcohol industry representatives)
- National Drug Research Institute,
- National Drug and Alcohol Research Centre, and
- National Centre for Education and Training on Addiction.
