Early intervention (such as physical therapies) for children with muscular dystrophy can vastly improve their long-term outcomes, resulting in a long-term cost benefit to the health system. Is FaHCSIA aware of any research that has been done into possible savings through early intervention in relation to muscular dystrophy?

Answer:
