Question

Transition to Remote Jobs and Community Program

Senator SCULLION: Of the applicants, how many are still currently trading as employment services? Ms Taylor: I do not think we will be able to tell you that at this point of time. Senator SCULLION: Even in a general sense, are many still trading as that—just as an indicative response—or you could take it on notice. Ms Taylor: I will take it on notice. It goes to identifying, perhaps, who has applied. Ms Milliken: I might add that current providers of existing programs—Job Services Australia, Disability Employment Services and CDP—whether or not they have applied to be Remote Jobs and Community Program providers and whether or not they are successful in that, would normally be expected to continue to provide the current programs until 30 June. For those who are not continuing, as for those who are successful, we will be working with them on the transition to RJCP.
