#### Senator Scullion asked:

When asked about remuneration of NCIE board positions at Senate Estimates, the ILC said that they compared the amounts to Remuneration Tribunal approved payments for other cultural institutions.

Were the other 'cultural institutions' not-for-profit charitable organisations? Please provide the names of the institutions referred to.

### **Answer:**

The Remuneration Tribunal determination for part-time office holders sets an annual fee for a variety of Commonwealth Government Boards/Committees.

The cultural institutions listed in the Remuneration Tribunal determination used by the Indigenous Land Corporation (ILC) as a comparison included National Library of Australia Council, National Museum of Australia Council, National Gallery of Australia Council and Australian War Memorial Council.

The National Library of Australia Council, National Museum of Australia Council, and Australian War Memorial Council all indicate in their 2011-12 audited financial statements that they are not for profit organisations.
