I refer to Mr Morony's letter of 17 March 2010 to the Chairperson and Board of Directors of Indigenous Business Australia. The following question relates to the attachment to the letter: Paragraph 1. Is it true that the IBA Board failed to ratify the September 2009 Board minutes for six months? Is it true that as the minutes/decisions were not ratified for six months \$2.4 million was unable to be transferred to the HOP program, thus denying some Indigenous clients the opportunity for new home loans totalling \$2.4 million during that period?

Answer:

The September 2009 Board Minutes were first considered by the Board at its following meeting on 8 December 2009 and adopted as a true and correct record on 23 March 2010. The Board were concerned about the quality of and time taken by Mr Morony and his staff to produce Board Minutes.
