I refer to Mr Morony's letter of 17 March 2010 to the Chairperson and Board of Directors of Indigenous Business Australia. The following question relates to the attachment to the letter: Paragraph 7. Is it true that the IBA Chairperson did not provide the IBA pay roll staff with the emails from other IBA Board Directors advising that they approved Mr Morony's annual pay increase?

Answer:

The Indigenous Business Australia (IBA) Board authorised the Chair to determine the pay increase for Mr Morony. The Chair, following consultation with Board members, determined the pay increase and notified the IBA Human Resource Manager and Mr Morony of the agreed increase.
