Question:

a) What pay TV subscriptions does your department/agency have? Please provide a list of what channels and the reason for each channel. What is the cost for this financial year to date?

- b) What newspaper subscriptions does your department/agency have? Please provide a list of newspaper subscriptions and the reason for each. What is the cost for this financial year to date?
- c) What magazine subscriptions does your department/agency have? Please provide a list of magazine subscriptions and the reason for each. What is the cost for this financial year to date?

Answer:

- a) Some areas of the Department purchase subscription television services to support departmental operations. There is no central register of service details.
 - The financial management information system is set up to combine all subscriptions which include purchase of books (technical and non-technical), videos, periodicals, journals, newspapers and subscriptions. For the Department to provide a specific breakdown of pay TV costs for the financial year to date would be an unreasonable diversion of resources.
 - The total cost for all subscriptions for the period 1 July 2012 to 31 January 2013 was \$386,059.
- b) Some areas of the Department subscribe to newspapers for information and reference to support departmental operations. There is no central register of subscription details.
 - The financial management information system is set up to combine all subscriptions, which include purchase of books (technical and non-technical), videos, periodicals, journals, newspapers and subscriptions. For the Department to provide a specific breakdown of newspaper subscriptions for the financial year to date would be an unreasonable diversion of resources.

The total cost for all subscriptions for the period 1 July 2012 to 31 January 2013 was \$386,059 as noted in answer (a) above.

c) Some areas of the Department subscribe to magazines primarily for the purpose of obtaining current information in specific professional fields or relevant to specific activities, thereby supporting departmental operations. There is no central register of subscription details.

The financial management information system is set up to combine all subscriptions which include purchase of books (technical and non-technical), videos, periodicals, journals, newspapers and subscriptions. For the Department to provide a specific breakdown of magazine costs for the financial year to date would be an unreasonable diversion of resources.
