How many participants are still on the 100 Places Program?

**Answer:**

The program was a one-off initiative in 1998-99 to provide 100 medical school places for overseas trained doctors who agreed to work in rural locations on completion of their medical degree and internship. The expected return of service period expired in 2011, so no people are currently considered to be participating in the program.
