Are lounge memberships provided to any employees? If yes, what lounge memberships, to how many employees and their classification, the reason for the provision of lounge membership and the total costs of the lounge memberships.

Answer:

Yes.

Lounge memberships may be provided to SES staff and frequent travellers. SES staff members are entitled to receive lounge membership as part of their remuneration package. Frequent Travellers may apply to their Branch Heads for lounge membership.

During the period 1 October 2012 to 31 January 2013 the Department of Health and Ageing spent \$11,092 (GST exclusive), for the purchase of 36 lounge memberships for periods ranging from one to three years.
