Question:

- a) How many cars are owned by each department/agency?
- b) Where is the car/s located?
- c) What is the car/s used for?
- d) What is the cost of each car for this financial year to date?
- e) How far did each car travel this financial year to date?

Answer:

a) and b)

There has been no change in the number of cars owned by the Department of Health and Ageing and Portfolio Agencies since the Supplementary Budget Estimates, October 2012.

- c) The Australian Radiation Protection and Nuclear Safety Agency (ARPANSA) advised that their vehicles are used for emergency response and training – supporting their role in radiological and nuclear incidents.
- d) ARPANSA advised that the total cost for the three cars is \$9,557 for the period 1 July 2012 to 31 January 2013.
- e) ARPANSA advised that the three cars travelled 1232kms, 102kms and 24kms for the period 1 July 2012 to 31 January 2013.
