Question:

a) For departments/agencies that provide mobile phones to Ministers and/or Parliamentary Secretaries and/or their offices, what type of mobile phone is provided and the costs?

- b) For departments/agencies that provide electronic equipment to Ministers and/or Parliamentary Secretaries and/or their offices, what are the ongoing costs for this financial year to date?
- c) Is electronic equipment (such as ipad, laptop, wireless card, vasco token, blackberry, mobile phone (list type if relevant), thumb drive) provided to department/agency staff? If yes provide details of what is provided, the purchase cost, the ongoing cost and a breakdown of what staff and staff classification receives it.
- d) Does the department/agency provide their Ministers and/or Parliamentary Secretaries and/or their offices with any electronic equipment? If yes, provide details of what is provided, the cost and to who it is provided.

Answer:

- a) The Department of Health and Ageing provides each of the three Ministers and Parliamentary Secretary, and their office staff with blackberry devices. The cost is \$600 excl GST per Blackberry device. No devices were purchased in the period 1 July 2012 to 31 January 2013.
- b) Costs for electronic equipment provided to the three Ministers and the Parliamentary Secretary and/or their offices, cannot be separated from the total expended for the Department/Agency. Therefore, to provide the level of detail requested would involve an unreasonable diversion of resources which the Department is not currently in a position to undertake.
- c) Yes; iPads, laptops, mobile broadband devices, blackberrys, mobile phones and thumb drives are available to some staff.

Details of what is provided, the purchase cost, the ongoing cost per device and a breakdown of what classification of staff receive these devices follow.

*i*Pads

- The department has 17 iPads. No iPads have been purchased in the period 1 July 2012 to 31 January 2013.
- A mobile internet plan is provided with each iPad that attracts a monthly charge of \$35 GST exclusive (\$421 annually).
- Senior Departmental Executives are provided with iPads.

Blackberry

- As at 31 January 2013 the department had 374 active blackberry devices.
- The current departmental standard Blackberry handset is the Blackberry 9900. The handset cost is \$600 GST exclusive.
- A monthly Blackberry data plan is provided with each Blackberry device that attracts a monthly charge of \$27 GST Exclusive. Actual phone charges are in additional to this.
- Departmental policy allows for the provision of Blackberrys to all SES staff and more broadly to departmental staff where a business justification is provided.

Mobile Phones

- As at 31 January 2013 the department had 691 mobile phone accounts.
- The approved departmental handset is the Nokia C5. The handset cost is \$212 GST exclusive.
- There is no monthly plan cost. Actual phone call charges are billed against each mobile account.
- Mobile phones are available to departmental staff where a business justification exists.

Mobile Broadband Devices

- The Optus E180 is the standard device approved by the department. The device cost is \$137 GST exclusive.
- The Department pays \$1000 a month for a mobile data pool shared between devices. Where there is a business justification based on mobile coverage needs a mobile data plan may be provided that attracts a monthly charge of \$40 GST exclusive (\$480 annually).
- Broadband devices are available to staff for use with departmental laptops where connectivity to the departmental network is required from remote locations.

Laptops

- The department has a pool of laptops purchased as part of a wider desktop refresh in the 2011-12 financial year. No laptops have been purchased in the period 1 July 2012 to 31 January 2013.
- The department pays a monthly support charge of \$78 GST exclusive per active laptop.

Thumb Drives

- No records are kept on the number of thumb drives within the department as these are managed by each divisional unit as part of general stationery purchasing.
- d) The cost for the purchase of electronic equipment for the period 1 July 2012 to January 2013 was \$12,474.

The Department provided each of the three Ministers and Parliamentary Secretary and their offices with the option to use a range of electronic and office equipment including a Blackberry, mobile broadband card, printer, portable computing devices, printers including secure Cabinet printers, televisions, DVD players, transcription kits, label makers and fax machines to undertake Portfolio related business.
