**Question:**

Is there any possibility that the system could fail such that sessions are paid for and then ultimately it is clear that those sessions have been beyond allocation, and in which case would be the consequences? If you could ask them (Department of Human Services) just in terms of potential issues about whether organisations will be required to refund money that they have received perhaps in error.

**Answer:**

The processing of sessions against the session allocation is monitored very closely. The Department of Human Services advises that there has been no occurrence of overpayment to date, however, should this occur under the *Financial Management and Accountability Act 1997*, overpayments are required to be recovered.
