Question:

In a previous question on notice, you identified that normative pricing models operate in other jurisdictions, including the UK, British Columbia and in some instances in the US. Why has there been a delay and no substantive work done to date on a normative pricing model in Australia?

Answer:

During 2013-14 the Independent Hospital Pricing Authority (IHPA) will continue reviewing the current policy of setting of the national efficient price at the ‘average cost’. IHPA’s future pricing policy process will include extensive assessment of international practice on normative pricing and will build upon the work undertaken to date, including the literature review. This process will include consultation with governments, other stakeholders and the public.
