# **Question:**

- a) Has the Department consulted with professional indemnity insurance providers regarding the potential ramifications for pharmacists of not responding to a Home Medicines Reviews, referral in the event of a moratorium?
- b) In the event of a moratorium, patients that have Home Medicines Review interview appointments made will need to be informed that they will be denied this service. Has the Department explored how this would be coordinated in the event of a moratorium? Has the Department investigated the costs associated with such an action?

#### Answer:

- a) The Minister for Health, the Hon Tanya Plibersek MP, announced on 11 February 2013 that she had decided not to pursue a moratorium on Home Medicine Reviews.
- b) As the Minister has announced a moratorium will not occur, no consultation has been undertaken.
