Question:

- a) Has the government done any further consulting on whether to extend the rebate for MRIs in relation to the PIP implants? There was an issue with some medical practitioners suggesting that, while the government's proposal for a period of 12 months was very welcome, it should be extended beyond that. Has there been any further consideration given to extending the MRI rebate beyond the initial period.
- b) It is for 12 months only at this stage?
- c) Has any analysis been done on the efficacy and the desirability of extending beyond 12 months?

Answer:

a-c) The Government has considered the status of the PIP MRI initiative and has made a decision to extend the timeframe for the initiative for an additional two years.
