Senator CAMERON: Under what instrument does the department derive the authority to deliver the interim FHA payments?

Answer:

The Department of Human Services administers Interim Farm Household Allowance under policy guidelines provided by the Department of Agriculture. The Commonwealth derives legislative authority for the Interim Farm Household Allowance from the *Financial Management Accountability Act 1997* and Schedule 1AB of the *Financial Management and Accountability Regulations 1997*.
