Question:

- a) How many people receive Carer Allowance (Adult) who are not in receipt of income support payment?
- b) Provide a breakdown of this by state and territory, gender, Indigenous status.
- c) What is the cost of providing this payment to people not in receipt of an income support payment?
- d) What are the costs of imposing a means test on this payment?

Answer:

- a) There were 106,396 people who were in receipt of Carer Allowance (Adult) as of December 2013 who were not in receipt of an income support payment.
- b) A breakdown of this customer cohort by state/territory, gender and indigenous status is in the tables below. Please note these breakdowns exclude recipients of income support and Carer Allowance Health Care Card only recipients. Recipients who qualify based on providing care for both an Adult and Child Care receiver are included in the count. Finally, Carer Allowance (Adult) and (child) customers appear in the data tables for Questions on Notice HS 26 and HS 27, therefore tables from these questions should not be added together.

- d) Carer Allowance (Adult) is not means tested. To provide a costing on imposing a means test would be better directed to the Parliamentary Budget Office.
