### **Question:**

a) Please provide the average time between receipt of an application for payment and final decision on application for every payment for every month since July 2012.

b) Please provide the average wait time between receipt of an application for a payment and receipt of payment for every payment for every month since July 2012.

#### **Answer:**

A payment is initiated when a 'granted' decision for a claim is finalised. Therefore, the results for (a) and (b) are the same.

As a claim may not be finalised in the same month in which it is received, this information is not reported on a monthly basis. The following table provides the average time to process a claim in 2012–13 and 2013–14 (as at 28 February 2014). This data includes granted and rejected claims.
