Question:

How many individuals in each of the following LGAs are on Income Management because they are under 25, have exited prison, and have received the Crisis Payment (if individual figures are unavailable, please provide the total figures):

- a) Playford;
- b) Bankstown;
- c) Shepparton;
- d) Logan; and
- e) Rockhampton?

Answer:

As at 27 December 2013 there were a total of 119 individuals who were under 25, exited prison and who had received a crisis payment being supported through Income Management in the identified locations. The distribution is as follows:

Measure	Bankstown	Greater Shepparton	Logan	Playford	Rockhampton	Total
Crisis Payment	<20	<20	49	25	28	119

Note: All cells that have a value of less than 20, including zero, have been changed to display '<20'. This rule has been employed for privacy reasons. Where the total fields are included, these will only have a value when it does not make it possible to work out the value of any '<20' fields.
