## Question:

How many Income Management clients in each of the following LGAs are: I) Under 50 years old; II) Under 30 years old; III) On Parenting Payment Single; IV) Female (if individual figures are unavailable, please provide the total figures):
a) Playford;
b) Bankstown;
c) Shepparton;
d) Logan; and
e) Rockhampton?

## Answer:

I) As at 27 December 2013 there were a total of 2,048 people under 50 years old being supported through Income Management in the identified locations. The distribution is as follows:

II) As at 27 December 2013 there were a total of 1771 people under 30 years old being supported through Income Management in the identified locations. The distribution is as follows:

III) As at 27 December 2013 there were a total of 94 people on Parenting Payment Single being supported through Income Management in the identified locations. The distribution is as follows:

IV) As at 27 December 2013 there were a total of 1,092 women being supported through Income Management in the identified locations. The distribution is as follows:
