Question:

How many Income Management clients in each of the following LGAs have received bonus payments for having spent: I) More than six months on Voluntary Income Management; II) More than twelve months? (If individual figures are unavailable, please provide the total figures.)

- a) Playford
- b) Bankstown
- c) Shepparton
- d) Logan
- e) Rockhampton?

Answer:

- I) As at 27 December 2013, there were a total of 145 people in the identified locations being supported through Income Management for more than six months who received the bonus payment.
- II) As at 27 December 2013, there were a total of 284 people in the identified locations being supported through Income Management for more than twelve months who received the bonus payment.
