Question:

a) How many Seasonal Work Preclusion Periods were applied in 2012-13?

b) Of the Seasonal Work Preclusion Periods imposed, what is the average preclusion period? Provide details of the types of payment affected in the numbers of each payment type affected.

Answer:

a) In 2012-13 there were 264 Seasonal Work Preclusion Periods applied.

b) The average preclusion period for this period was 51 days. Payments affected and the number of preclusion periods for each of those payment types appear in the table below.

Payment Type	Number SWPP	Average Length (Days)
Austudy	<20	75
Carer Payment	<20	57
Disability Support Pension	<20	64
Newstart Allowance	214	50
Parenting Payment Partnered	<20	35
Parenting Payment Single	<20	64
Sickness Allowance	<20	13
Youth Allowance	<20	49
TOTAL	264	51
