### Senator Ludwig asked:

- 1) How does the department test it is complying with accessibility standards for its websites?
- 2) Does the department comply with accessibility standards for all its websites?
- 3) What would be the effect on the accessibility rating of the department's website if FOI PDFs were provided on the department websites?
- 4) What accessibility testing of the website was done and what were the points of failure prior to this change in access for FOI documents?
- 5) Have the website accessibility standards been solely or partly responsible for not putting FOI PDF documents on the department websites?

#### **Answer:**

- 1) The Department of Social Services (DSS) has completed significant work in relation to education and testing for WCAG 2.0 compliance. DSS has implemented a testing regime using a mixture of automated and manual assessment methods to identify accessibility issues and correct where necessary.

- 3) DSS already provides all FOI documents in PDF format on its Departmental website. The Department followed a risk-management approach on the accessibility of FOI documents taking into consideration resources required to provide handwritten and redacted material in accessible formats.
- 4) DSS has provided all FOI document requests in PDF format on the Departmental website since the Information Publication Scheme came into effect on 1 May 2011. Prior to this date the website did not conform to WCAG guidelines due to its previous technology platform.
- 5) DSS has provided all FOI document requests in PDF format on the Departmental website since the Information Publication Scheme came into effect on 1 May 2011.
