**Topic:** Disability Support Pension (DSP)

### Senator Moore asked:

How many people on the Disability Support Pension have been placed in a job and sustained work (13 and 26 weeks) through the Program of support measure?

#### **Answer:**

The Program of Support (POS) measure began on 3 September 2011. As at 31 December 2013:

- 390 placements in a job were recorded;
- 255 13-week employment or education outcomes were recorded;
- 159 26-week employment or education outcomes were recorded.

<sup>\*</sup>Note - most of the DES 13 AND 26 week outcomes are estimated to be employment

Due to limitations in the data, the Disability Employment Services (DES) 13 and 26 week outcomes cannot be broken down separately for education and employment.

Note: the data that is collected only measures Job Services Australia (JSA) and DES outcomes. Under the POS measure, there are number of other types of placements that can be made, however, the data from these placements is not collected.
