Why was a deadline given for spending and why was their funding later withdrawn?

What are the names of these organisations?

Who instructed these organisations to spend their funding?

Were these instructions given via a phone call or in a letter? If via a phone call, why not in writing?

Answer:

Organisations were not called by the Department.

Following the Government review of discretionary grants, the Government decided to reduce the scope of the Building Multicultural Communities Programme. The Department of Social Services gave written notice of the cancellation of funding agreements for Stream 1 grants, effective on 4 February 2014. The Department of Social Services advised all affected parties that reimbursements would be made in respect of expenditure incurred by that date.
