I refer to HS 35 from previous estimates and note that social workers delivered 77,557 face to face appointments in 2013-14 and received 30,251 referrals from Centrelink call queues.

- a) Given the Government's 2014-15 budget measures which cause further distress to those people on the DSP and Newstart has the Department seen an increase in social worker referrals from 1 July 2014?
- b) If so, will the Department seek to increase the social worker staffing level?

Answer:
