### **Ouestion:**

a) What measures has FSANZ taken to monitor the market for raw milk?

b) Can you advise in which Australian jurisdictions raw milk is available for purchase, even if marketed for use as a cosmetic?

## Answer:

- a) Food Standards Australia New Zealand (FSANZ) develops food standards, which are incorporated into the *Australia New Zealand Food Standards Code* (the Code). The Code specifies that milk must be pasteurised (or equivalently treated), unless a state or territory regulation specifically permits the production and sale of raw milk. State and territory governments implement and enforce the requirements of the Code.
- b) There are four states that currently permit, through their legislation, the production and sale of raw goat milk: Queensland, New South Wales, South Australia and Western Australia.
