**Senator Brown** asked:

The Children and Parenting Support Funding Round Summary states that services funded under the Children and Parenting Support Program component could include community playgroups, supported playgroups, parenting courses, home visiting and peer support groups. Are you able to provide a breakdown of the successful funding applications by these different support types?

**Answer:**

Under the Children and Parenting Services component, providers are funded to deliver a variety of services targeted at children aged 0-12 years (up to 18 in some instances) and support the capacity of those in a parenting role. The mix of services delivered will vary depending on the location, service provider, and needs of particular communities.
