**Answer:**

As part of the Department's mandatory reporting requirements, outlined in the Commonwealth Grant Rules and Guidelines, the Department of Social Services (DSS) is required to publish advice on new providers and the funding they have received by programme. This information is made available on the [DSS website \[www.dss.gov.au/about-the-department/overview/grants-funding\]](http://www.dss.gov.au/about-the-department/overview/grants-funding) no later than 14 working days after the grant agreement for the grant takes effect. This information is updated weekly. DSS publish the programme name, recipient, purpose, approval date, identification number, period/term of the grant, location and value.
