## **Senator Joe Ludwig** asked:

Since the change of Prime Minister on 14 September, 2015:

- 1. How many ongoing staff have been recruited? What classification are these staff?
- 2. How many non-ongoing positions exist or have been created? What classification are these staff?
- 3. How many staff have been employed on contract and what is the average length of their employment period?

#### **Answer:**

1. Excluding changes as a result of Machinery of Government, from 14 September 2015 to 31 December 2015, 37 ongoing employees were recruited by DSS at the following classifications:

Excluding changes as a result of the Machinery of Government, as at 31 December 2015, 184 non-ongoing positions existed.
