- 2. As at 2 March 2016, the current inventory of computers owned, leased, stored, or able to be accessed by the department is 4805, comprising:
  - National offices, Canberra 3541 (currently still supplying computers for and supporting Aged Care staff recently moved back to the Department of Health via Machinery of Government changes)
  - State offices, South Australia 184
  - State offices, Queensland 232
  - State offices, Tasmania 76
  - State offices, Victoria 255
  - State offices, New South Wales 375
  - State office, Northern Territory 45
  - State office, Western Australia 97

The DSS fleet of computers is made up of 15 various types of Dell machines (PC's and laptops), as well as a small number of Microsoft Surface Pro's. Each of these types of computers has a differing purchase price.

IT assets have a depreciation period of three years. The majority of the DSS fleet of computers is over four years old and as such fully depreciated. Of the remaining assets, the majority of these are partway depreciated.

3. The Department's computers run the operating systems Microsoft Windows 7 Enterprise or Microsoft Windows 8.1 Enterprise. These operating system contractual arrangements are under the Whole of Government VSA II Core Desktop Licence (CDL) which is operated by the Department on Finance.
