Does the department have data on the impact of the changes to the treatment of income from defined benefits? I am interested in their average annual income and the amount of the impact - the reduction. Say somebody is on a pension of \$11,400. What is the impact of these changes on them? How much would they lose, if they would lose? Including a break-down of the total affected group by \$10/fortnight increments eg, how many lost \$10/fortnight, how many lost \$10-\$20/fortnight and \$20-\$30 etc. Are you able to provide information to us about the number of pensioners across income brackets at all? I am interested in knowing the average income for people who have been impacted and by how much. Is it possible to get it state by state?

Answer:
