Senator Moore asked:

Do NDIA staff travel business class when flying to Darwin for official work?

Answer:

The National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA) has adopted the Whole of Australian Government travel policy.

When undertaking official domestic air travel, NDIA officers are required to consider the lowest practical fare in economy class unless there is a strong case to travel business class.

However, Senior Executive Service (SES) officers may travel business class if the total one-way flight duration is greater than two hours.
