Answer:

- a) Population Health and Sport Division.
- b) It was a limited tender using the Department of Finance's Communication Multi Use List (CMUL).
- c) Attitudes, intentions and behaviours among girls and young women regarding physical activity and sports participation.
- d) The purpose of this research is to evaluate the Physical Activity and Young Women Campaign (Girls Make Your Move). The campaign budget is \$9.9 million.
- e) The research is being conducted nationally.

- f) A benchmark survey has been conducted with a follow-up survey to be conducted after campaign activity has ceased. Each phase will comprise a nationally representative online survey of girls and young women aged 12-21 (n=1200) and parents of teenaged girls (n=800).
