Question:

a) What level of post-market monitoring has been completed by NICNAS or other agencies on the environmental impact of microbeads on Australian waterways?

b) How many products in the Australian market contain microbeads?

c) Has NICNAS commenced any work, either with industry, or government, or other

stakeholders, to review our current standards as they relate to Microbeads?

d) What actions is required to be undertaken by NICNAS, or by Government, to bring Australian standards on microbeads into line with overseas jurisdictions like the United States.

Answer:

- a) Environmental monitoring of waterways does not fall within the scope of the National Industrial Chemicals Notification and Assessment Scheme (NICNAS).
- b) NICNAS does not register individual products, so does not hold information on the number of products in the Australian market containing microbeads.
