Question:

How many and which bands are considered on a western blot test for a positive diagnosis to be made? Who established that criteria?

Answer:

The interpretation of in vitro diagnostic assays is a function of pathologists and medical laboratory scientists responsible for test authorisation and reporting. Reporting criteria are based on the in vitro diagnostic device manufacturer's product information as well as relevant epidemiological data and internal test validation studies.
