### **Question:**

What specifically makes the National Efficient Price a "very good mechanism", as Secretary Bowles stated at Estimates? (Community Affairs, 3 March 2016)

#### **Answer:**

One of the key features of Activity Based Funding (ABF) has been the independent determination of a National Efficient Price (NEP). The NEP provides a price signal or benchmark about the efficient cost of providing public hospital services. The ongoing use of a NEP for hospital services is an effective way to provide incentives for the states, as public hospital system managers, to improve their productivity and cost effectiveness.
