### **Question:**

Senator DI NATALE: To what do you attribute the decrease over that period? Mr Cormack: Essentially there was an increase in effort by both the Commonwealth and the states. The Commonwealth is part of a National Partnership Agreement, so there was a funding element there. The state and territory governments all overachieved on their targets. That agreement had a national target to treat an additional 400,000 public dental patients. With that being achieved, you would certainly expect over time for those waiting lists to go down.

Senator DI NATALE: That was with that initial injection.

Mr Cormack: Yes.

Senator DI NATALE: Do you have any indication? You are saying February is the next lot of data you are waiting for?

Mr Cormack: Yes, it is.

Senator DI NATALE: Is there any indication about whether those waiting lists are blowing out?

Mr Cormack: We probably need to take that on notice rather than speculate because also currently there is an interim agreement in place which is specifically focused on adult programs—that is the \$155 million—and that is a target of another 176,000 people. So it is moving around. But certainly the level of Commonwealth commitment in this current one-year agreement period is at the high point of previous funding commitments by the Commonwealth and states.
