Question:

Mr Cormack: Just to complete the list, the early psychosis program and the new Indigenous \$84.75 million in new Indigenous specific programs will transition. They have not really started yet so they will go straight to commissioning from 2016-17. I think at a program level that pretty much makes up those year-by-year bottom line figures that you referred to.

Senator GALLAGHER: How many are in that group of people under the national program that you were going to maintain a funding relationship with? It would not be very big, would it?

Mr Cormack: There are a few.

Senator GALLAGHER: I tried to look on your spreadsheet.

Ms Cole: We can provide you with more detail on notice, but it includes organisations such as beyondblue, the Butterfly Foundation and that sort of organisation. Those that have that national leadership.
