Senator ROBERTS: Can you advise as to what the suicide rate is for men aged 44 to 49, because you have said that the suicide rate for Australians is 12.7 per 100,000 people. Mr Cormack: I do not think we have that with us right at the moment, but we will get that figure for you, hopefully before we break today.

Senator ROBERTS: Can you advise as to how many men aged between 20 and 24 take their lives?

Ms Cole: Would you like a table which—

Senator ROBERTS: Yes, please. How about the rate in the Northern Territory?

Ms Cole: We can get that to you on a state-by-state basis as well.

Senator ROBERTS: And particularly for the Northern Territory. Would you agree that this is an important issue that transcends age, gender, ethnicity or geographic region and that it needs to be addressed?

The following two tables present the age-specific suicide death rate per 100,000 for males and the number of suicide deaths for males, by five year age groups from 2006 to 2015. Data is from the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) *Causes of Death, Australia, 2015* released on 28 September 2016.
