### **Question:**

When will the next round of funding for the Specialist Training Program be announced and is the Government committed to:

- a) Maintaining funding at or above current levels?
- b) Providing better certainty around rural training posts with the provision of longer-term funding (ie 3-5 years)?

#### **Answer:**

The next round of funding for the Specialist Training Program (STP) is currently under consideration by Government.

Over \$537 million has been allocated for specialist training programs over the period 2018-2020, which includes the Government's new investment in the Integrated Rural Training Pipeline measure. This represents an overall expansion of funding support compared to the preceding period.
