Question:

a) When will service delivery actually start under the pilot? How many patients will be enrolled in the program by this date? When will the target of 65,000 patients be reached? b) How much funding has been spent on the pilot to date?

Answer:

a) Health Care Home services will now have a deferred and phased start, with up to 20 Health Care Homes commencing on 1 October 2017 and the remainder commencing on 1 December 2017.

There is not a set target of enrolments for the commencement date. The stage one trial is intended to provide for a gradual patient enrolment in Health Care Homes based on population usage of Medicare chronic disease management items. With this modelling, full enrolment is reached over the course of 12 months.

b) A total of \$2,305,839 (GST exclusive) in administered funds has been expended by the Department of Health on the Health Care Homes measure, as at 20 March 2017.
