April 2015	Mental Health Drug and Alcohol Principal Committee (MHDAPC) tasked by Australian Health Ministers' Advisory Council (AHMAC) to establish a Fifth National Mental Health Plan Working Group
June 2015	Establishment of the Working Group
August 2015	Targeted consultation workshop with stakeholders held to determine priority areas
October 2015	Priority areas endorsed by AHMAC
November 2015	Priority areas endorsed by Council of Australian Governments (COAG) Health Council
January – October 2016	Consultation draft developed in consultation with stakeholders
October 2016	Consultation draft endorsed by MHDAPC
October 2016	Consultation draft publicly released to support national stakeholder consultation activities
November/December 2016	National consultation activities held
December 2016	AHMAC approves a 3 month extension of the timeline to ensure comprehensive analysis and synthesis of extensive stakeholder feedback
