#### Question

#### **AEC Jobs**

Senator SIEWERT: Do we know the nature of the jobs that are being filled? Ms Wood: We do not have detail on the specific jobs. We know the sectors in which they are being filled, which are quite wide-ranging, including construction, community services, business services, mining, transport, employment service providers, banking and retail. There is a whole range of sectors that are covered with employers of a range of sizes and locations.

Senator SIEWERT: Can you provide a breakdown of the 635 into those sectors? Ms Wood: We will take that on notice to see if we have that level of information. We will provide it if we can.

Senator SIEWERT: That is fine. Are we talking full-time jobs?

Ms Wood: I expect it would be a mix of full time and part time. I do not know if we have that information, but we can take that on notice also.

Senator SIEWERT: When AEC provides those figures, are they providing a breakdown in terms of whether they are part time or full time?

Ms Wood: I do not think so, but I will check. We are counting job placements, so we are counting individual people placed into jobs, whether they are full time or part time.

Senator SIEWERT: Could you take that on notice, please?

#### Answer

The AEC reported to the department the following information in relation to 1048 jobs where 26 week outcomes have been achieved as at 11 July 2011. These are forjobs for which the relevant data has been reported by employers.

The following industries are represented:
