Answer:

headspace has advised the Department that undertaking the range of activities within its Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander strategy over the next three years will contribute to the following outcomes:

- increased participation in the workforce, education and community through individuals and families;
- improved health outcomes for Aboriginal and Torres Strait islander young people and families as a result of access to training, information, education, increased cultural security, connection and reduction in addiction, ill health, family violence and suicide;
- improved access to and delivery of evidence based treatment by more culturally appropriate diagnoses, intervention and models of care and development of a skilled and trained workforce; and
- contribution to development of an evidence base by data collection, evaluation and research.
