Senator Payne asked:

How much money is expected to be spent by IBA on support services for HOIL clients?
How much money has been spent by IBA on these support services to date?

Answer:

Indigenous Business Australia (IBA) expects that the average amount of funds for support services will not exceed \$13,000 for each Home Ownership on Indigenous Land (HOIL) client.

To date IBA has spent \$218,327 on support services for 26 clients, 16 clients of whom proceeded to take out a loan.
